

Link-up Working Groups

During the inaugural Link-up Steering Group Meeting held on 21st September 2011, it was agreed to publish the dates and information on the new Working Groups. These Groups are integral to the new governance model for the Link-up Scheme and are initiated by the Steering Group to analyse and develop solution concepts for specific topic areas.

There are 5 Working Groups to be set up as part of the initial governance changes and they are as follows:

- Sustainability
- Link-up v3 Platform
- Product Codes
- Link-up Audit
- EU Procurement Law

Membership of the Working Groups is open to anyone with an interest and/or involvement with the rail industry and is not reliant on Link-up membership, which is why this information is being published on the login page of the Link-up Portal and not restricted to post login access.
